New milestone: Highest volume on a single vessel

APM Terminals Pipavav has achieved a new milestone of handling the highest volume on a single vessel in July 2018. We handled 6125 TEUs on Maersk Shivling of FM-3 Service. We surpassed our own benchmark of handling 5,682 TEUs on APL Boston of CIX - A service in November 2017.

The FM-3 service connects Pipavav to the Far East.



New rotation: Singapore call added on CI-1 service

APM Terminals Pipavav is pleased to advise the addition of Singapore call on CI-1 service on the eastbound leg. The rotation now will be :

Shanghai - Ningbo- Shekou – Nansha -Singapore
– Nhava Sheva – Pipavav – Singapore -
Shanghai

This addition of Singapore call further strengthens the connectivity of Pipavav to key South East Asian markets. Exporters of agricultural products would be benefitted by this new rotation.
