

MARINE DEPARTMENT
PORT RECEPTION FACILITIES AS PER MARPOL

As per the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL), it is strictly prohibited to throw garbage, oil, or any other harmful substances overboard inside port areas. This is to prevent marine pollution and protect the marine environment.

The Master of the Vessels calling at the Pipavav Port shall utilize the services of any of the empaneled service providers for disposal of wastes from the ships as and when required.

The list of service providers is given below in Annex 1 & 2 and the Masters shall engage the Service providers at their choice and shall make payment as per the tariff directly or through the Vessel's Agent to the Service Provider.

The requirement of the Reception Facility with the details of the waste and quantity or any feedback on the reception facility may also be sent through e-mail to inppvportcontrol@apmterminals.com.

PROCEDURE FOR EMPANELMENT OF WASTE OIL RECYCLERS IN PIPAVAV PORT FOR COLLECTION OF OILY WASTES FROM THE SHIPS

- I. The GPPL is permitting the Recyclers authorized by the GPCB for collection of oily wastes from the ships as and when required by the ships as a measure of providing Reception Facility to the ships as per the MARPOL Regulations.
- II. The waste oil recyclers having authorization from Gujarat Pollution Control Board are eligible for empanelment for collection of waste oil from the ships calling at Pipavav Port.
- III. The recyclers having valid authorization from the GPCB shall submit a request to the marine department/ HSSE (Environment Section) enclosing copies of the consent / authorization issued by the pollution Control Board along with the documents mentioned in Annex 3.
- IV. After verification of all documents, if everything is in order, and if satisfied by the Harbour Master/Assistant Harbour Master/Head HSSE the firm will be registered for empanelment for collection of waste oil from the ships as and when required by the Masters of the vessels.
- V. The newly empaneled Recycler will be included in the list of Recyclers permitted for collection of oily wastes from the ships and the same will be published in the Port's website.
- VI. The empanelment will be valid till the period of validity of the authorization issued by the GPCB to the Recycler.
- VII. The Recycler in the Empaneled list shall strictly comply with all the Customs Rules and Regulations, GPCB Rules and Regulations and other statutory Regulations of the Port and other Government Departments / Organizations.
- VIII. The name of the Recycler will be removed from the list of the empanelment whenever any violations of any Rules / Regulations are noticed / brought to the knowledge of the Harbour Master of Pipavav Port.
- IX. The Harbour Master reserves the right to accept / reject the request of any firms for registration and empanelment for collection of oily wastes from the ships at Pipavav Port and his decision will be final in this regard.
- X. All the transportation of Hazardous waste shall follow Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2016 and its amendment.
- XI. Recyclers will produce disposal certificate after treatment/disposal of oily waste to the Environment Section of HSSE of Port Pipavav.

Terms and Conditions for Waste Oil Recyclers for collection of oily waste from the ships calling at Pipavav Port.

- a. The Recyclers authorized by the Central / state Pollution Control Board shall be empaneled in the Pipavav Port for collection of oily wastes from the ships.
- b. The Recyclers will be kept in the empaneled list as long as their Authorization issued by the Central Pollution Control Board/ GPCB is valid.
- c. The Recyclers shall be required to comply with the Conditions / Regulations of Central Pollution Control Board / Gujarat Pollution Control Board / Customs and Pipavav Port.
- d. No Recyclers / Company will be allowed for collection of oily wastes from the ships at Pipavav Port without the valid authorization from the Central / state Pollution Control Board.
- e. Advance Notification Form is to be submitted by the vessel in the "Swaach Sagar" portal of DG(Shipping)
- f. The Masters of the ships desirous of discharging the oily wastes at Pipavav Port shall, directly or through their agents engage one of the GPCB Authorized recyclers in the empaneled list of Pipavav Port.
- g. The Recyclers shall carry out the collection of oily wastes from the ship after obtaining permission from the Harbor Master, other Pipavav Port authorities and clearance by the Customs.
- h. The recyclers providing the service of collecting oily wastes shall be required to submit to the Marine Department the details of quantity of oily wastes collected from the ships after collection. Those recyclers who are not submitting the details will not be allowed for subsequent collection of oily wastes from the ships at Pipavav Port.
- i. The recyclers are required to fix RFID / GPS tracking system in the vehicles used by their firm for collection of the oily wastes, so as to ensure proper disposal by the firm which has collected the oily waste from the ship for disposal. Failure to adhere the above condition may result in withdrawing the registration of the firm in Pipavav Port.
- j. The recyclers are required to submit copy of the Form - 10 of Transport manifest of the waste oil collected from the ship and receipt at the recycler's unit.
- k. The decision of the Harbour Master is final and binding in this regard.

Guidelines for registration of the Private Firms for collection of Garbage

from the ships calling at Pipavav Port

- 1 The private firms authorized by the Rajula Municipal Corporation or having consent of private firms engaged by Municipal Corporation of Amreli District for solid waste management shall be empaneled in the Pipavav Port for collection of garbage from the ships.
- 2 The Private Firms will be kept in the empaneled list as long as their Authorization issued by the Municipal Corporation or having consent of Gujarat Pollution Control Board.
- 3 The recyclers having valid authorization from the GPCB shall submit a request to the marine department/ HSSE (Environment Section) enclosing copies of the consent / authorization issued by the pollution Control Board along with the documents mentioned in Annex A.
- 4 The Private Firms shall be required to comply with the Conditions / Regulations of Municipal Corporation, Customs, GPCB and Pipavav Port.
- 5 No Private Firms will be allowed for collection of garbage from the ships at Pipavav Port without the valid authorization issued by Municipal Corporation/ GPCB.
- 6 The Masters of the ships desirous of discharging the garbage at Pipavav Port shall, directly or through their agents engage one of the Private Firms in the empaneled list of Pipavav Port.
- 7 The Private Firms shall carry out the collection of garbage from the ship after obtaining permission from the Harbour Master, other Pipavav Port authorities and clearance by the Customs and other authorities.
- 8 The Private Firms providing the service of collecting garbage shall be required to submit to the Marine Department the details of quantity of garbage collected from the ships. Those Private Firms who are not submitting the details may not be allowed for subsequent collection of garbage from the ships at Pipavav Port.
8. The Private Firms are required to fix RFID / GPS tracking system in the vehicles used by their firm for collection of the garbage, so as to ensure proper disposal by the firm which has collected the garbage from the ship for disposal. Failure to adhere the above condition may result in withdrawing the registration of the firm in Pipavav Port.
9. ANF is to be submitted by the vessel in the "Swaach Sagar" portal of DG(Shipping)
10. The decision of the Harbour Master is final and binding in this regard.
